Reminders as we start the 2014-2015 season...

- The NAWGJ Canons can be found on the NAWGJ website, but here are a couple of highlights -
- A judge should avoid even the appearance of professional impropriety
- A judge should be well qualified in gymnastics, know the rules, and be thoroughly prepared for each assignment.
- A judge should be completely unbiased. A judge should not give any appearance, especially at a meet, of any particular friendship with any coach or competitor.
- A judge should treat gymnasts, coaches, judges, promoters, and spectators with respect.
- A judge should at all times both look and act professionally.
 - A judge should exercise good judgement when using social networking media.
 - The attire for meets is navy blue pants or skirt, a white top, and a navy jacket or NAWGJ embroidered sweater. When meets request that we wear a certain color or theme, that is fine, but please dress professionally.
 - Please arrive to your meets in a timely fashion, and do not leave the floor before the session is complete.

Judges Cup will be held the weekend of December 19-21 at Paramount Sports Complex. Please save the date and plan on volunteering at some point during the weekend.

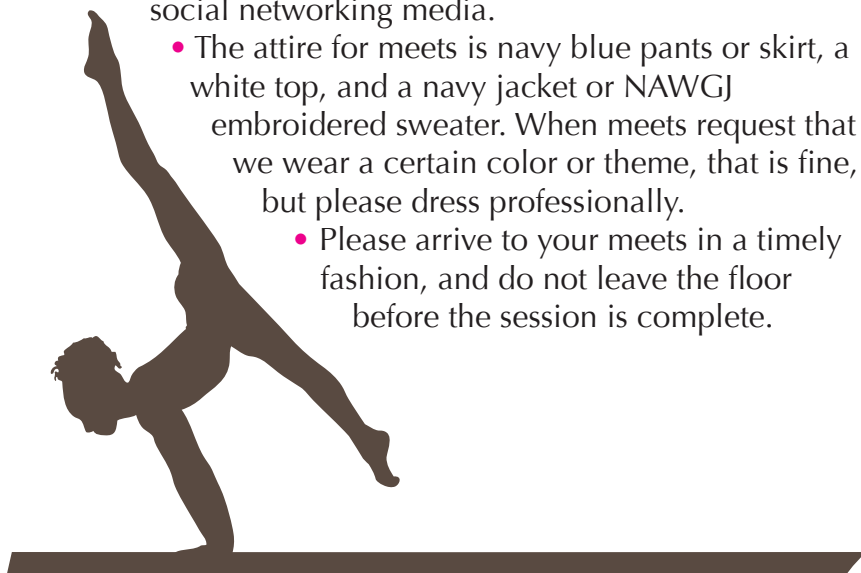
VOUCHER!

There are other USAIGC clinics out of state that may work better for you. These clinics have been emailed out and can also be found on the USAIGC website (www.usaigc.com).

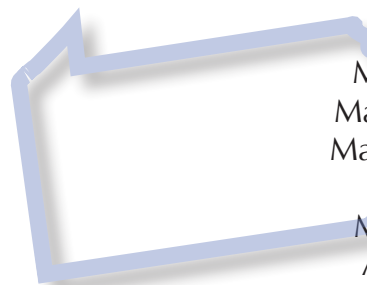
REMINDERS/UPDATES

Please NO solicitation!
Our personal information is to be used for professional reasons only.

- For **ALL** meets you are assigned to you are required to send your USAG number to the meet director prior to the meet.
- If you are an affiliated judge, and you are listed as a head judge when event assignments are released, please let your meet referee or event assigner know immediately so that she may make the proper changes.
- The CPE requirements for all levels of judges are listed on page 53 & 54 of Rules and Policies.
- **If your CPE credits are not up to date, you may not be assigned to sanctioned meets.** In an unusual circumstance where there is an absolute necessity to assign a judge who is delinquent in completing their CPE credits, the judges' compensation will be reduced by \$5.00 per hour. Please refer to pages 65-68 of the Rules and Policies for further information pertaining to CPE credits.
- Please let Terry McGirk, Toni Kardos and Marcy Blitz know if any of your information in the judges directory is incorrect so we can correct it.
- If any of your information changes (i.e. rating, address, etc.) please notify NAWGJ, USAG and the SJD.
- Please do not wait until the last minute to renew your USAG membership, safety certification, and/or background check. If any of your dates are not current, you will not be allowed on the floor at a sanctioned meet.
- If you are on any medication, please keep a list of your medications in your purse in case of emergency. Also, be sure to carry on your medications if you are flying to any away meets.

Once you achieve a new rating, please let Terry McGirk know right away. You may not be assigned if we do not have up-to-date information on your rating.

If you are attending National NAWGJ Symposium or National Congress and have registered as part of the NAWGJ group please note that on your voucher so it can be crossed-checked against the list supplied to Mary Ann Olson.

All vouchers will be reimbursed to the total amount of the receipts up to \$100.00. I.e. if the receipts total \$80.00 total reimbursement will be \$80.00.

All receipts must be **itemized**. **Please send the voucher and all original receipts in one envelope. Mary Ann will only be writing one check per person. Please also provide a self addressed stamped envelope with your voucher and receipts.**
