Quiz Korner | Questions

Test your knowledge with the following questions (answers can be found later in this newsletter) -

1. A level 8 gymnast performs a switch leap on beam with a 90° bend of the lead leg and a 180° split with straight legs following the leg change. Which of the following statements is correct?
 - A. Award an "A" value part for a stag leap forward with leg change
 - B. Award a "B" value part for a stag leap forward with leg change
 - C. Devalue the skill to a "B" value part for insufficient extension of the lead leg and take up to 0.1 for lack of extension of the lead leg
 - D. Award a "C" (counts as a "B") value part with a deduction of up to 0.3 for the bent leg
2. A developmental optional athlete falls on a cast handstand on the HB. When resuming her routine, the gymnast performs a glide kip, climbs onto the LB, performs a long hang kip and completes the routine. Which statement below is correct?

- If you are an affiliated judge, and you are listed as a head judge when event assignments are released, please let your meet referee and event assigner know immediately so that she may make the proper changes.
- **If your CPE credits are not up to date, you may not be assigned to sanctioned meets.** In an unusual circumstance where there is an absolute necessity to assign a judge who is delinquent in completing their CPE credits, the judges' compensation will be reduced by \$5.00 per hour. Please refer to pages 32 of the Rules and Policies for further information pertaining to CPE credits.
- If any of your information changes (i.e. rating, address, etc.) please notify NAWGJ, USAG and the SJD, as well as updating your GymJas account. .
- Please do not wait until the last minute to renew your USAG membership, safety certification, safe sport and/or background check. If any of your dates are not current, you will not be allowed on the floor at a sanctioned meet.
- If you are on any medication, please keep a list of your medications in your purse in case of emergency. Also, be sure to carry on your medications if you are flying to any away meets.

ELIGIBILITY FOR REGIONAL MEETS

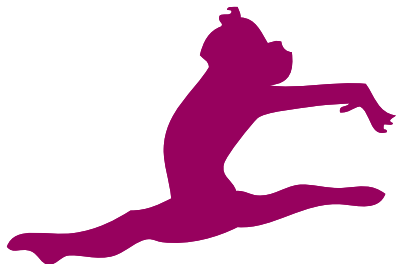
To be eligible to judge a USAG Regional meet in 2025 you must volunteer at any of the following Region 7 events:
